



<b>All After</b>	Used when you need to have part of a message repeated.
<b>All Before</b>	
<b>Correct</b>	Correct is used when somebody has read back a message and it is all correct. We say wrong if it isn't as 'incorrect' may get confused with 'correct'.
<b>Wrong</b>	
<b>Correction</b>	Used if you make a mistake in your message and have to put it right.
<b>In Figures</b>	Used to distinguish between letters and numbers.
<b>I Say Again</b>	I'm going to repeat.
<b>I Spell</b>	I'm going to spell phonetically.
<b>Out</b>	I have finished speaking and the conversation is finished.
<b>Over</b>	I have finished speaking and expect a reply
<b>Radio Check</b>	Used when asking another station if you are clear and readable

<b>Read Back</b>	Please read my message back to me.
<b>Received</b>	I have received your message.
<b>Say Again</b>	Please repeat your message.
<b>Station Calling</b>	Used instead of the call sign or vessel name of the person calling you as you did not catch it or understand it.
<b>Text</b>	Used when you are reading a message verbatim which you expect to be written down.
<b>Traffic</b>	General term meaning radio communications.
<b>This Is</b>	Said when identifying yourself at the start of a call.
<b>Wait</b>	Means please wait for me as I'm not ready. Let them know how long!
<b>Word After Word Before</b>	Used when asking for a single word to be repeated or spelled.
