**Notice of Race (NOR)**

*The abbreviation "[DP]" in a rule stated in this NOR means that the penalty for breaching the rule is at the discretion of the protest committee, who may judge the infraction more lenient than disqualification.*

<b>1</b>	<b>Rules</b>
1.1	The event is managed according to the rules defined in <i>the Racing Rules</i> , including the following: Nordic Sailing Federation and Danish Sailing Association rules.
1.2	In addition, the following rules apply: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Statutes for Denmark's Sailing Championships defined by the Sports Confederation of Denmark (DIF).</li> <li>• Danish H-boat Association class rules</li> <li>• Maximum wind strength for not starting is set at 12 m/sec. Further information and details will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.</li> <li>• There must be 2-4 persons on board whom, in total - wearing underwear, must not weigh more than 300 kg. The number of people enrolled in the event must be on board during all races in the event – this rule cannot be altered.</li> <li>• The number of sails that can be registered and used during the championship is limited to 1 Mainsail and 2 Jibs, and 2 Spinnakers. One spinnaker must be sealed at the registration. The sealed spinnaker may only be used in case of major damage to the unsealed spinnaker and, if used, the race committee shall be made aware of this as soon as possible.</li> </ul>
1.3	The Racing Rules have been amended as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• RRS 35, A4 and A5 are changed so that boats that do not complete within 20 minutes of the first boat are noted DNF.</li> <li>• Rule 44.1 is changed to replace the two-round penalty by a one-round penalty.</li> <li>• RRS 60.1(a) is amended so that a boat cannot object to certain parts of the sailing rules.</li> <li>• RRS 62.1(a) is amended so that a deviation in the sailing time of the first boat cannot form the basis for redress.</li> <li>• RRS A4 and A5 are changed so that boats that start later than four minutes after the start signal are noted DNS.</li> </ul> <p>The precise wording of the changes will be set out in the Sailing Instructions.  The Sailing Instructions may also amend other racing rules.</p>
<b>2</b>	<b>Advertising</b>
	Boats may be required to display advertisements chosen and handed out by the organizing authority. [DP]
<b>3</b>	<b>PARTICIPATION AND REGISTRATION</b>
3.1	The event is open to H-boats with a valid class certificate and the crew shall additionally satisfy the membership criteria of Danish H-boat Association (DHBS) or another national H-boat class organization, recognized by the International H-Boat Association (IHA). In relation to the Danish Championship statutes' provision, the title of Danish Champion and associated medals are won by the best-placed crew who all are members of a Danish sailing club. Membership of a Danish sailing club must have been obtained prior to the races, and documented at the time of registration.
3.2	Boats that qualify for participation can be registered online via <a href="https://www.gillelejesejklub.dk/">https://www.gillelejesejklub.dk/</a> before August 16, 2020. Registration is valid once Gilleleje Yacht Club has received the payment.
3.3	Later entries are accepted for boat crews at a surcharge of 400 DKK, if the authorities' announcements of the number of participants due to COVID-19 restrictions can be complied with. However, no entries will be accepted after August 24, 2020. <b>4</b>	<b>Payment</b>
4.1	The fee for participations is: 3-Man crew: 1.600,00 DKK

<b>5</b>	<b>Timetable</b>		
5.1	Registration at the race office will be open from 3:00 pm to 9:00 pm, Friday, August 28, 2020 as well as 7:00 to 9:00 am on Saturday 29, 2020.  Registration will take place at the premises of Gilleleje Yacht Club. Gilleleje Yacht Club, Beddingskajen 4, 3250 Gilleleje – Denmark.

	Saturday August 29, 2020	10.55 am	No restrictions
	Sunday August 30, 2020	09.55 am	No restrictions
	No more than 10 races will be completed.		
	On Sunday August 30, 2020, no warning signal will be given after 3:00 pm if the Statutes for the Danish Championships in Sailing are met.		
	Lunch breaks of 20 min. duration may be afforded, at the discretion of the Race Committee.		
<b>6</b>	<b>MEASUREMENT</b>		
6.1	Participants may be weighed at the race office when boats are registered.		
6.2	There may be control measurements and safety checks before and during the event – boats selected for checks, will be published on the notice board and on the water in connection with race completion. Measurement checks under the "Danish Sailing Measurement Control Regulations" and class provisions may occur before, during and after the races.		
6.3	In connection with the registration of boats and participants, the following documents are required: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Crew shall meet the membership criteria of Danish H-boat sailors (DHBS) or any other national H-boat class organisation of the International H-Boat Association (IHA).</li> <li>• Proof of membership of a sailing club for all sailors</li> <li>• Loan declaration if you sail in borrowed boat.</li> <li>• Valid liability insurance and class certificate.</li> <li>• Sail button numbers must be provided upon registration. This is done by filling in the "Registration of Sails" form.</li> </ul>		
<b>7</b>	<b>Sailing Instructions</b> The Sailing Instructions will be available on the Gilleleje Yacht Club website by Friday August 21, 2020.		
<b>8</b>	<b>Place</b>		
8.1	The event is conducted from Gilleleje Yacht Club, Beddingskajen 4, 3250 Gilleleje – Denmark.		
8.2	The race course will be located in the waters immediately off Gilleleje Harbour. In the interests of spectators, the aim is to put it as close as possible to land.		
<b>9</b>	<b>Race Courses</b> Race courses are up/down with guide mark after the top mark. The bottom marks are gates. Finishing will be downwind or beam reach. The course length objective is to have the first boat complete the race in 45 mins.		
<b>10</b>	<b>Penalty System</b> RRS 44.1 has been amended to replace the two-round penalty by a one-round penalty.		
<b>11</b>	<b>POINTS</b>		
11.1	4 races are required to meet the criteria for a valid Danish Championship.		
11.2	(a) If fewer than 4 races are completed, the score of a boat in the series will be equal to the sum of the boat's points from each race.		
	(b) If 4 or more races are completed, a boat's score in the series will be equal to the sum of the boat's points from each race – minus the worst score of one race.		
<b>12</b>	<b>COACH VESSELS</b>		

	Team leaders, coaches and other escorts shall register boats in the race office. Boats shall keep a minimum distance of 50 meters to any participating boat.
<b>13</b>	<b>LOCATION OF BOATS</b> Participating boats can be located free of charge in Gilleleje harbour from Friday August 29, 2020 to Sunday, August 30 2020. Boats shall comply with any instructions of the organisers regarding location in the port [DP].
<b>14</b>	<b>RESTRICTIONS ON HAULING</b> Keel boats shall not be hauled during the event, unless they comply with the written conditions and approval of the race committee. [DP]
<b>15</b>	<b>DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS</b> Diving equipment, plastic basins and similar equipment may not be used near keel boats after the first warning signal for the first race and until after the last race. [DP]
<b>16</b>	<b>Radiocommunication</b> When a boat races, it shall not broadcast or receive voice and radio signals which are not accessible to all boats, except in emergency situations. [DP]
<b>17</b>	<b>Prizes</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Sports Confederation of Denmark's Danish Championship medals will be awarded to the first three Danish rankings, in accordance with Danish Sailing Associations statutes for Danish Sailing Championships.</li> <li>• Prizes are awarded for every 5<sup>th</sup> boat registered.</li> <li>• Points are counted for the Danish H-boat Association Liga Championship.</li> </ul>
<b>18</b>	<b>LIABILITY</b> Participants participate in the event at their own risk. (See RRS 4, Decision to participate.) The arranging authority does not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death arising from participation before, during or after the event.
<b>19</b>	<b>Insurance</b> Each participating boat shall maintain a valid third party liability insurance. The coverage shall be as follows: Material Damage: 500.000 EUR Injury/Death: 1.000.000 EUR Total Liability: 1.500.000 EUR
