

Beyond animal testing, transitioning towards OOC: OOC Transition Initiative

Application Terms and Conditions (the Terms and Conditions)

Objective of the Call

At Bi/ond we believe that a future without animal testing is possible, and Organ-on-Chip (OOC) technology is working on providing more accurate and cruelty-free models. The accuracy and the success of these models will be the result of joint efforts between research, industry and associations. Together with associations we are launching a call for researchers in the OOC field. The objective of this call is to promote and accelerate the development of OOC models, using Bi/ond' product, with the potential to reduce and replace animal testing.

Challenge Procedure

Eligible criteria:

Researchers working in academic institutions located in the European Union and the United Kingdom. The call is open only to researchers and groups that are currently not early adopters of Bi/ond (BIOND Solutions BV).

To qualify for the research grant, applicants must meet the following conditions which are set out below:

- 1. The research performed within the OOC Transition initiative is both 100% free of laboratory animals and does not involve animals in any other way. This means that Bi/ond will not fund project that use slaughterhouse material or animal species falling outside the definition of the Animal Experiment Act;
- 2. The partners are willing to participate in communication about the research via Bi/ond and our supporter channels. Example include interviews, newsletters, photos, videos, etc. These forms of communications are always agreed in advanced with the parties involved;
- 3. Where the applications concern in vitro models, the use of Fetal Calf serum (FCS)-free media is strongly advised.

Review Process:

Applications for the call OOC Transition initiative will be reviewed by dedicated Bi/ond innovation committee. All submissions will require the following information:

- Applicant General info (name, address, employment information, email, phone)
- Public summary (max 1000 characters)
- Innovation Level & Relevance to the 3R (max 1000 characters)
- Objectives (max 1000 characters)
- Concept/Methodology (max. 2000 characters)
- Project Team (max. 1000 characters)



- Implementation (max 1000 characters)
- Is the technology patent protected (if so, provide the primary patents)
- Do publications exist for the technology (if so, provide fundamental publication)

In this call, the proposals are assessed according to the following four assessment criteria:

- 1. Problem posed and problem analysis, contribution to solution;
- 2. Expected impact and route to impact to replace animal testing;
- 3. Quality of the team;
- 4. Quality of the research.

Criterion 1 carries 25% weighting in the overall assessment, criterion 2 a weighting of 35%, and criteria 3 and 4 carries both a weighting of 20%.

The submissions will then be evaluated by Bi/ond innovation committee and the winning proposals will be selected. The committee will grade the proposals using the criteria listed above. The applicants will be informed about the evaluation of their proposal on the 14th of January 2021. No rebuttal phase is planned for this grant.

The call will open on the 13th of October 2020. The deadline for submitting full proposals is the 17th of December 2020, 5 pm CET. Only proposals submitted within the call timeline will be considered.

Award

The winner of the call will receive an in-kind contribution from Bi/ond, with an estimated value of €15,000.00. With this budget, Bi/ond will help the winner to transition from their current model to one based on OOC.

This grant will cover the following costs:

- · Organ-on-chip hardware (inCHIPit™ and comPLATE™);
- · F2F trainings;
- · Online support.

Project duration: six months.

The remaining applicants who will not receive the grant, will be eligible for a 20% discount on Bi/ond' products to be used by the end of 2021.

Intellectual Property
