Portable electrical heaters...

- Never use them to dry clothes.
- Try to secure heaters up against a wall to stop them falling over.
- Always unplug the heater when not in use.

Open fires...

- Protect your home by using a fire guard to prevent hot ash and sparks falling from the fire.
- For wood and coal burning fires or stoves, the chimney should be swept according to the type of fuel used. To find a chimney sweep in your local area, please visit: www.nacs.org.uk

Gas fires

They should be checked at regularly and once a year by an engineer.

We recommend you install at least one carbon monoxide alarm when using open fires and solid fuel burners.
