

TRAUMA AND MENTAL HEALTH CARE





There have been many cases of drug abuse in many communities of Zimbabwe. The cases has left I Care so iShare and other stakeholders with a pivotal role to play to eradicate this problem that poses harm to the health of young people.

The organisation continues offering sensitization programs towards children mainly aged between 14 and 18. More than 500 students continue receiving lessons important aspects of life. We shall continue to be committed to ensuring that young people are removed in harm's way through the sensitisation much needed in different communities both in urban and rural areas.
