EUKI at a Glance

Financing instrument by the German Federal Environment Ministry (BMU) established in 2017

Objective is to support climate protection through inner-European dialogue, exchange of good practices and creation of networks of climate pioneers

Taget groups are NGOs, civil society, (local) governments, eductional institutions, businesses

Geographic focus is on EU Member States with a focus on Central-Eastern, South-Eastern and Southern Europe



Strengthening knowledge and raising awareness in order to encourage climate protection and the ecological, social and economic opportunities connected with climate action.



Fostering the exchange of good practices, transfer of knowledge and experience and building of networks in order to support transformative processes and favourable framework conditions for mitigation of greenhouse gas emissions.



Building a bridge to EU programmes through capacity building as well as leveraging European funds into innovative and progressive climate action.


