



METHODOLOGY




- Map the latest trends in INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY'S INTEGRATION;




















- √ 7% of respondents reported experiencing discrimination
 - The most-reported form of discrimination, with
 25 responses, is discrimination based on ethnicity.
 - Other responses included discrimination based on: gender (9 responses), religion (8), age (6), or sexual orientation (3).
 - No respondent felt that they had been discriminated against on the basis of a disability.












 - No respondent felt that they had been discriminated against on the basis of a disability or sexual orientation.














 - No respondent felt that they had been discriminated against on the basis of a disability.














 - No respondent felt that they had been discriminated against on the basis of a disability, age, or sexual orientation.














 - No respondent felt that they had been discriminated against on the basis of a disability, gender, or sexual orientation.













