





First visit:


- 1. Initial assessment of needs and expectations, receiving of referrals.

Other visits:


- 1. Assessment (continued).
- 2. Training with visual devices, visual skills, and/or other skills (mobility, daily living, communication).


LOW VISUAL ACUITY







CENTRAL SCOTOMA
