Under a radiant sun, the scientific symposium 'Ectopic calcification in (healthy) aging and disease' brought UGent and International partners together, working on the various aspects of ectopic calcification. From rare disorders such as pseudoxanthoma elasticum or Keutel syndrome to common diseases such as osteoarthritis and diabetes mellitus, the whole spectrum of clinical manifestations with

ectopic calcification was presented. Novelties in ectopic calcification treatment, including innovative biomarkers as the T50 time and targeting inflammation were discussed as well as comprehensive overviews of the use of animal and cell models to better understand the mechanisms leading to ectopic calcification.
