


The Via Emilia

The construction of the road began in 189 B.C


The mind of all this was Consul Marcus Emilius Lepidus (from which stems the name of the road),

With a total length of about 230 kilometers, Via Aemilia connected from South-East to North-West the extremes of the region: firstly, connecting the preexisting centres, such as Piacenza, Rimini and Bologna and secondly, forecasting new cities, such as Modena and Parma (183 B.C.) and Reggio Emilia (175 B.C.).

Bobbio

This small medieval town is a travellers' delight, a feast of ancient legends and modern cinema in the heart of the High Val Trebbia, dubbed “the most beautiful valley in the world” by none other than Ernest Hemingway.


Bobbio's origins are something of a mystery. Its history is closely intertwined with the famous St Columban's Abbey and the legendary Devil's Bridge.



Abbazia di San Colombano

Visiting Bobbio is like stepping back into the Middle Ages. Through the faith and foresight of an Irish monk, St Columban, this remote corner of the Apennines became the pulsating heart of medieval religious culture in Europe. It was around the abbey, in fact, that the lop-sided town first grew. The abbey became a large monastic complex, it houses the ancient scriptorium and the library that inspired Umberto Eco's "The name of the rose".








Antica Corte Pallavicina



Tabiano Castello




The map illustrates a road trip from Modena to Bologna. The route then follows the E45 to Borgo Panigale, where it meets the A14. Finally, the route continues along the SS9 to Bologna (49 min).




Monteveglio








Rocchetta Mattei

The castle called "Rocchetta Mattei" owes its name to the count Cesare Mattei (1809-1896) who had it built on the ruins of an ancient building dating back to the thirteenth century, the Rocca di Savignano. The castle structure was developed several times by the count during his life and by his heirs, making it a labyrinth of towers, monumental stairways, private rooms that still recall different: from the neo-medieval to the neo-Renaissance, from the Moorish to the Liberty.







Ferrara
