This is an Unofficial List, This list is NOT Mehadrin. All products are either kosher certified or kosher compliant, but not certified.

There is no kosher meat, chicken, cheese or wine in Albania

You can contact Rabbi Yoel Kaplan who is both Chief rabbi of Albania as well as Chabad Shliach in Albania and Thessaloniki. Contact him through Chabad.org/Thessaloniki. He has some kosher items imported from Israel and France available

There is no Chalav Yisrael or Pat Yisrael or Bishul yisrael or Affiya Yisrael in Albania

KC--Kosher certified

Kme – Kosher certified mehadrin

Kco--Kosher compliant. Visual inspection, not formally certified

Some products are kosher certified by Rabbis in Croatia, Serbia or Italy

NY-Tirana Bagels has good bagels. (not mehadrin)ONLY the bagels are kosher compliant

Mullixhiu—a restaurant in building at entrance to Artificial Lake. ONLY the Bakery and the ground flours are kosher. Their breads are very natural. Flours are ground daily.

All frozen or fresh dough that has only flour, water, and with or without salt is kosher. Avoid those with margarine or fats.

Select brand Pita, found in some supermarket freezers

NY-Tirana Bagels---all bagels, smoked salmon

Veggies restaurant is in process of becoming kosher. Target date for a kosher menu is September 2018

ANY RESTAURANT. Anywhere

Vegetable salad, no onions or garlic. No vinegar. Use olive oil and fresh lemon

Fish in Foil—choose a kosher fish (has scales). Have them dress with olive oil, salt, herbs, lemon. Wrap in foil. Can now be baked, grilled or in fry pans

Vegies in Foil—(same procedure as for fish)
