#### EDUCATION

#### Kent Science Resource Centre

Next weekend (4th May) there will be a course on Swarm Control led by Julian Audsley. Swarming is likely to start a little later this year but I see my stronger colonies have had drone brood for a few weeks now so perhaps we will again be caught napping as Nature catches up with a poor start to Spring? Swarm control is typically not well executed, a shame for such a key aspect of beekeeping? Several places are available for Julian's course.

Courses in June include one on Varroa (1st June), looking at recent developments in our attempts to live with this serious pest while on 19th June, Alan Byham will be leading a session

on Foulbrood recognition, including an opportunity to examine the diseases in the comb. On 6th July, Mary Hill will repeat her course on "How to pass The Basic".

#### Basic Bee Husbandry

This is a follow on from a beginners course being run by Nick Mengham for six weeks starting on Thursday, 23<sup>rd</sup> May from 6.00 to 8.00 p.m. It is a practical course using live bees, focusing on basic beekeeping skills in a little detail and includes bee management, swarm control, queen rearing and honey processing. Candidates should have attended a basic beekeeping course or similar. The curriculum will prepare candidates for the BBKA basic bee husbandry assessment although it may be advisable to do more study in order to enjoy success.

Cost: £40.00 Protective clothing will be required but may be borrowed by arrangement.
