After nearly two decades of meticulous documentation, I am finally ready to share Czech Cancellations 1.0 with you. It is an online Catalogue of all Czech cancellations from the period October 28 1918 to March 14 1939.

My Mission

My mission is to gather and show all Czech cancellations from 1918 to 1939 used by the post offices in the Czech Lands, Slovakia and Ruthenia in a single place and make it easy for you to access them. The catalogue is based on the Monografie Československých Známek Volume 16, 1 + 2, and Volume 17, 1 + 2 with several corrections and supplements. The numbering from Volume 17 is used. The catalogue is divided into three parts now:



Postal Offices Catalogue

Are you looking for information on a postal office or a train track? Do you want to know how many cancellations they had? - then search the Postal Office Catalogue.



Regular Cancellations catalogue

Are you looking for information on a specific Cancellation? - Then look through the regular Cancellation catalogue.



Bezirk Cancellations catalogue

Do you have a bezirk Cancellation and don't know where it is from or for how long it was used? - Then you can search the bezirk Cancellation catalogue.

In version 1.0, I have included ordinary post office postmarks, Bezirk (District number) postmarks and Travelling Post Office (T.P.O.) postmarks, - with more than 35.000 cancellations registered and many more to come.

What's next?

I have planned the following extensions to the catalogue:

2.0 - Cancellations for post-bags on T.P.O.'s for forward transmission

3.0 - Special cancellations

4.0 - Advertisement cancellations

5.0 - Field post cancellations

Following information is found in the catalogue for each cancellation:

Explanations

Image - Image of the Cancellations type, not the exact Cancellations.

Cancellations Type - The official Cancellations type as defined in the monograph.

Postal Office - Refers to the official name of the postal office.

Cancellations Number - The official Cancellations number as defined in the monograph.

Official Period Of Usage - The officially registered period the stamp should have been used.

Registered Period Of Usage - The period of usage that has been registered in our catalogue.

Broken Text - Text has been broken off.

Broken Black - Part of the Cancellations has been blacked out.

Broken Off - Part of the Cancellations has been broken off.

Reversed Date - The date has been reversed.

Date In Red - The date is written in red ink.

New Registration - New Cancellations cannot be found in the monographie.
