1. Services Provided

La Pâtissière agrees to provide private one-on-one classes to the Client for the purpose of teaching them all the skills and techniques used at La Pâtissière. The classes will cover topics such as baking and decorating cakes (celebration cakes to wedding cakes), desserts as well as business management. Each topic will be divided into modules based on the Client's previous experience and build from there.

2. Schedule and Location

The classes will be scheduled at mutually agreed-upon times and will take place at the Client's kitchen or at a location provided by La Pâtissière. The duration of each class will be defined in writing prior to the signing of this contract.

3. Recipes

The recipes used at La Pâtissière are included in the private classes.

4. Fees

- Hourly charges for classes where the Client uses and practices with their own ingredients, tools, equipment, supplies in their own kitchen: \$100 per hour.
- Hourly charges for classes including the use of ingredients, tools, equipment and supplies in a commercial kitchen provided by La Pâtissière: \$175 per hour.

5. Payment

A deposit of the cost of the first hour of class is due a minimum of one week before the first class is scheduled, subject to availability. Balance payment for each class is due in full 24 hours prior to the beginning of the first class. The Client may pay by cash, e-transfer or credit card (through PayPal).

6. Cancellation Policy

The Client must provide at least 1 week's notice if they wish to cancel or reschedule a class. Cancelling a class between 5-7 days before class will result in a cancellation fee of 50% of the cost of the class. Cancelling a class 4 days or less before class will result in a cancellation fee equal to 75% of the cost of one class.

7. Liability Waiver

The Client acknowledges that participating in the classes may involve some level of risk, and agrees to release and hold harmless the Instructor from any liability for injuries or damages incurred during the classes.

8. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the provincial laws of Ontario and federal laws of Canada.

9. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings, whether written or oral, relating to the subject matter of this Agreement.
