Samburu - Ol Pejeta - Lake Nakuru - Masai Mara



Seven Day Tour - Itinerary

This tour takes you to the Kenya's best destinations offering diversified game. We transverse the central highlands, north of the Equator and visit Samburu National Reserve. The Reserve provides opportunity to view a range of wildlife unique to the north; Beisa Oryx, Gerenuk, Grevy zebra, Reticulated giraffe and Somali ostrich. The Samburu communities surround the Reserve.

You will enjoy game drives at Ol Pejeta Conservancy situated at the foothill of Mt. Kenya, Kenya's highest mountain, with an optional visit to Sweetwaters Chimpanzee Sanctuary for orphaned and abandoned chimpanzees. This private ranch is home to rhinos, elephants, lions, leopard and giraffes among others.

Drive on the floor of Great Rift Valley with a short visit at the Thompsons falls before enjoying a game drive at Lake Nakuru National Park, birds are plenty and view Black and White rhinos up close.

Lastly, we visit the famous Maasai Mara Reserve. Home of the Big Five, great wildebeest migration, cheetahs, giraffes, antelope, eland, buffalos and many others.

Day 1: Nairobi - Samburu National Reserve

Depart Nairobi in the early morning and drive north, with a brief stop at the equator. On a clear morning you will enjoy beautiful views of Mt. Kenya; Kenya's highest mountain. Proceeding further north to Samburu National Reserve. We will view game on our way to our accommodation, enjoying a late lunch and prepare for early evening game drive.

Day 2: Samburu National Reserve

Your day will be spent enjoying the Reserve's beautiful landscapes and unique species only found in the northern parts of Kenya, Reticulated giraffe, Grevy Zebras, Gerenuk, Beisa Oryx. In addition, are lions, leopard, cheetah, hyena, wild dogs and elephants, as well as many bird species like the vulturine guinea fowls and the Somali ostrich.

Optional visit to a local Samburu village.

Day 3: Samburu - Ol Pejeta Conservancy

Depart after breakfast for Ol Pejeta Conservancy, situated at the foothill of Mt. Kenya. Picnic lunch followed by an afternoon game viewing in this Conservancy.

Ol Pejeta Conservancy is one the popular safari destinations in Kenya due to its proximity to the City, easy reach and the fact that it hosts the big five [rhinos, lion, elephant, leopard and buffalo].

Similarly, it's the only place in Kenya where one can see chimpanzees. The Sweetwaters Chimpanzees Sanctuary was founded as a rescue home to the orphaned and abandoned chimpanzees.

Day 4: Ol Pejeta - Lake Nakuru

We depart early for Nakuru passing through Nyahururu and a short visit at the Thompsons Falls, another ideal sight for bird watchers and picnic. We proceed to Lake Nakuru National Park and enjoy an afternoon game drive.

Masai Mara in Kenya is adjacent to Serengeti National Park in Tanzania, both are famous for the annual wildebeest migration in July through October where animals move in patterns in search of pastures.

Optional additional activities include balloon ride and/or cultural Masai village visit.

Day 5: Nakuru - Maasai Mara

We drive to Kenya's best wildlife viewing destination, Maasai Mara. We enjoy our first afternoon game viewing before first overnight stay.

Day 8: Masai Mara - Nairobi

After breakfast we head for a morning game viewing before exiting park and driving back to Nairobi.

Day 6 & 7: Maasai Mara

The next two days are spent in search of wildlife across this massive reserve. Despite its vast plains, our guides know it intimately, and there is abundant wildlife such as lion, leopards, buffalos, antelopes, hippos, giraffes, cheetahs, hyenas and many more.
