A mentoring program for persons with refugee status

Who are you?

You have refugee status in Denmark, and you are looking for support in how to navigate the labor market, education system or everyday life in Denmark. You speak English or Danish at a conversational level.

What is the offer?

A mentorship with voluntary mentors working in companies such as Novo Nordisk and IBM. You will meet approx. twice a month for a period of 3-6 months.

The mentor can offer guidance and support in:

- How to find a job
- How to gain access to the educational system
- How to make use of existing skills and experiences in a Danish setting
- How to navigate the Danish system regarding residence permits, housing, etc.
- How to settle into everyday life in Denmark

How does it work?

Based on your interests and preferences, Foreningen Lige Adgang will try to find a mentor that matches your profile. If we find a match you both agree to, we will ask the mentor to reach out to you. Once your mentorship has started, it is up to you and your mentor to schedule your meetings. We will follow up by phone to provide support for you and to help you overcome potential obstacles.

Who are we?

Foreningen Lige Adgang has promoted equal access to job, education and communities for everyone in Denmark since 1998. In collaboration with companies, public institutions, civil society organizations, private funds, and volunteers, we focus on social responsibility with the principle that we must work together across differences to treat everyone equally. With the current crises forcing people to flee their homes and settle in countries such as Denmark, we are launching this mentoring program for persons with refugee status.
