The Pangea side is newly painted and the changingroom and toilets are completely renovated. Gaia's side will wait until the Christmas holidays. This week it is still "summer preschool", next week Jura and Trias will be on the Pangea side while the 3-5 year olds are on the Gaia side.

We work together but have divided the children into smaller base groups so that they have as much space as possible to learn and develop. We have many topic rooms on the Gaia side, the ICT room and two more on the Pangea side that all base groups use and collaborate on. We do not have the "traditional" idea that one group of children stays in the same room/s, as this can lead to a decrease in the cooperation between teams and groups of children and that the children receive different quality of materials and learning environment. Instead, we focus on accessibility and the design of learning environments is created based on the aspirational goals in the preschool curriculum and the children's various interest projects.
