SATURDAY 25TH MAY 2024

WALK 1

Bus 09.00 hrs

ANGLE BAY CIRCULAR

Starting from the car park in Angle, we proceed along the Pembrokeshire Coastal Path, passing the strangely named Rat and Sheep Islands until we reach Gravel Bay where we turn inland and walk across open fields as far as the Lodge where we rejoin the Coastal Path back to our starting point on West Angle Bay.

WALK 2 CRESSWELL OUAY

This walk commences from the historic and quaint Cresswell Quay. The walk takes us through farmland and woodland and through quiet country lanes with glorious views of the River Cresswell and Carew. Our lunch stop wil be taken near the Carew Tidal Mill and its 23 acre tidal pond with its bird life and castle views. After lunch we make our way back to Cresswell Quay and the welcoming Cresselly Arms.

NEWPORT TO FISHGUARD

Starting from The Parrog Car Park we follow the Pembrokeshire Coastal Path with its spectacular sea views. On this route we will walk through the beautiful Cwm Yr Eglwys with the remains of The Church of St Brynach on the sea front. We will also walk around Dinas Head and carry along the coast to our ultimate destination which is Lower Fishquard Harbour.

After lunch we complete this circular walk by rejoining the coastal path and returning to the safe haven of Newport.
