**Wednesday, 29th May 2024**

**Walk 1:**

Location: Cwm Mawr Circular

Length: 5.5 miles (approx) Grade: C+

Registration will open at 9am on Sunday, 26th May 2024 and will close at 9am on Wednesday, 29th May 2024

Additional Information: The route of this country walk in the Gwendraeth Valley should offer some great views of the surrounding area, weather permitting! It will take us along quiet country lanes and a short section of cycle path as well as across fields and open parkland. We will also meander through woodland and along riverside paths within Mynydd Mawr Woodland Park. *Please note that there are two short sections of road walking (there is a pavement).*

*Please note that there are two inclines along the route (hence the grading) which can be taken at our own pace. Please note also that ... although the majority of the route is firm underfoot, some of the paths in the woodland have exposed roots and some areas of the parkland are boggy. There are also some sections of stony ground and some muddy patches around gates. Walking boots are therefore recommended and a walking pole could be useful in places.*

Parking for the walk will be in the main car park of Mynydd Mawr Woodland Park in Heol Hirwaun Olau, Lower Tumble (Postcode: SA14 6HU).

Directions to the car park from Llanelli:

- Take the main road through Felinfoel, Swiss Valley and Llannon and drive towards Tumble / Cross Hands
- Drive through Upper Tumble and take the SECOND left on the corner by the shop and drive down through Tumble
- Continue down the hill past the houses, shops and the school and, when the road levels off, turn RIGHT into Heol Hirwaun Olau *just before* the road sign for the village of Cwm Mawr - there is a brown sign directing you to Mynydd Mawr Woodland Park
- Take the next LEFT and drive along the access road to the main car park - *please note that* the traffic calming 'bumps' along the access road are quite severe - there are four of them!

The walk will start from this car park at 10.30am.
