Think like a Historian - Investigate and Communicate	
Cause	Reasons how or why events or states of affairs occurred or emerged.
Consequence	Things that occurred because of an event or development.
Change & Continuity	When something changes over time and when some things stay relatively the same over time.
Similarity & Difference	Historical analysis of the extent and type of difference between people, groups, experiences or places usually in the same historical period. To recognise similarities between the groups above.
Significance	Focus on why events, trends and individuals are historically significant.
Chronology	Place historical periods or events in time order and discuss their chronology in relation to other time periods.
