RATHVIDEN

A strong contender after excellent recent performances. Jockey Ruby Walsh has two previous winners and, at 40, this could be one of his last chances to claim a third.

Approx Odds:10/1

PLEASANT COMPANY

A horse with a good record in the National, including running Tiger Roll incredibly close in last year's race. Trainer Willie Mullins won the race in 2005.

Approx Odds: 20/1

VALSEUR LIDO

Was well placed last year before fading. Jockey is Rachael Blackmore who is looking to become the first female jockey to win the race.

Approx Odds: 66/1

BLESS THE WINGS

A longshot and the oldest horse in the race. One of trainer Gordon Elliot's nine horses in the field. Could be an outside bet for a place after finishing third last year.

Approx Odds: 100/1
