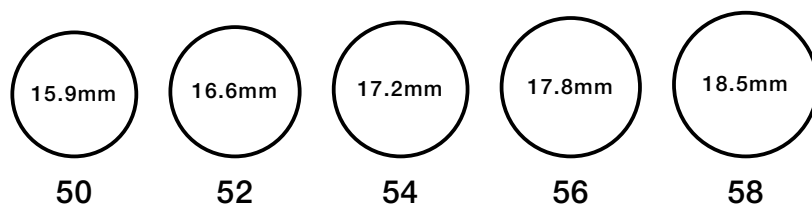


# HOW TO EASILY MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

Tip: When choosing a ring size, do not only consider your ring finger. Your index finger, middle finger, little finger and even your thumb can be perfect for a beautiful ring.

## 1

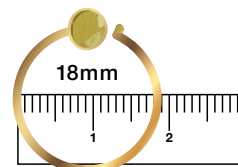
Print this page on A4 and place a ring that fits you well on one of the circles. Do the circle and the inner diameter of the ring match? Then you've found the correct ring size.



## 2

Keep a well-fitting ring ready. Measure the inner diameter of the ring. Compare the number of millimeters with the corresponding size in the table. Please note that a wide ring feels a bit tight on the finger, so choose a ring that's half a millimeter bigger.

Diameter (mm)	Ring Size
16 mm	50
16.5 mm	52
17.25 mm	54
18 mm	56
18.5 mm	58



## 3

In case you don't have a ring, measure the circumference of your finger using a ribbon or string. Don't measure it too tight, but loosely around the finger. Then measure the length of the ribbon or string with a ruler. Lastly, compare the millimeters with the corresponding size in the table.

Circumference (mm)	Ring Size
50 mm	50
52 mm	52
54 mm	54
56 mm	56
58 mm	58
