

ONBOARDING

- the process of screening your suppliers

By onboarding your suppliers, you will be able to reach a **level 3 screening** with our tool. The purpose is to define the exact conditions that relate to your product. Typically, this will lead to a reduction in your production impact which translates directly to a reduction in your overall climate impact regarding that product. This is due to the conservative approach from our baseline tool.

Multiple benefits occur when the onboarding is complete. First of all, you have reached a level 3 screening option, meaning low uncertainty and high precision. Secondly, we have mapped the production of your supplier, which gives us valuable insight and allow us to give recommendations on future production scenarios for the supplier. This both helps strengthening the relations between you and your supplier and help the supplier accelerate their green transition by realizing their environmental impact which in turn means more environmental friendly products for you.

PRICE: The price ranges from 25.000 DKK to 55.000 DKK.

Things that affect the price include:

- How many production/manufacturing lines the supplier operates in. Dividing many manufacturing lines takes more time
- How many of these product groups (glass, metal, textile, wood, etc.) you want onboarded from one specific supplier
- If the supplier uses unconventional methods, additional time is required to gather data and model



We estimate approximately 2 months for the onboarding process, where most of the time is used by the supplier to gather data.

However, unexpected external variables can affect the timeframe, hence we need information on the specific supplier before we can give a more precise estimate.

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The process step by step

The onboarding process requires little from you. We will be available to you and your supplier throughout the process, answering questions and giving updates.

NB: We need to see at least three of your component screenings relatable to the specific supplier to verify the results.

What we need from you

- 1 You will receive a leaflet from us, explaining the requirements from the supplier to be successfully onboarded in our tool
- 2 You choose the supplier you want to onboard and forward the leaflet (we provide consultation if needed)
- 3 Based on the leaflet, you and the supplier agree that all criteria can be met
- 4 You provide general information to us about the specific supplier and the products you buy, so we can make a rough remote screening to accelerate and specify the next steps

We take over from here

- 5 We will contact the supplier, answering any questions they might have
- 6 We request all the needed information
- 7 When having received the data, we immediately start our calculations and modelling
- 8 We verify the results with the component screenings you have made
- 9 The results are shared with the supplier along with a few recommendations on how to improve their production
- 10 The results are shared with you based on the components you have chosen
