**Maths:**

This week in maths, Year 3 have; placed 3-digit numbers into the right position in the place value chart, counted in 50's and compared and ordered different numbers. Can your child tell you which number is greater, 472 or 482? How do they know?

**English:**

In English this week, Year 3 have been looking at extended noun phrases, using adjectives to describe nouns from the settings in our class book *Wild*. We have learnt how to edit a text and how to up level our work by using the thesaurus. We have published our setting description beautifully and they will be displayed along our corridor. Next week, we will be looking at how to develop detailed character descriptions for a narrative.

**RE:**

This week in RE we have discussed Incarnation. Year 3 have discussed about how God came to life among humans and how Jesus portrayed his message and his miracles. Can your children tell you the definition of a miracle and name any miracles they have learnt this week?

**Spellings:**

This week's spellings are words which have /n/ sound spelt 'kn' and 'gn' at the beginning of the words. For example: Know, Knee, Knock, Gnat, Gnaw. Please practise reading these words as well as writing them in sentences. Your child should write these in their green home-learning books.

**Science:**

This week we have investigated how water is transported through the plant. We have carried out a fair test where we put 4 carnations in different coloured water and placed it in different temperatures. Can your child tell you what happened to the flowers?
