Learning this week: We have worked on narratives this week, with the intention of entertaining our audience. Learning about the parts of a river from the source to the mouth was fascinating. However, what was really absorbing was to have found out on our trip to Beddington Park yesterday, that the River Wandle used to be teeming with trout a hundred years ago, and that the river was re-channelled so as to make way for housing as the local community grew. This just goes to show how social factors impact on how rivers and landscapes change. Geography is a lovely subject to learn.
