Learning this week:

All children completed a range of assessments in reading and mathematics this week. Their science learning focussed on air resistance, which as they discovered is a force that slows down objects in the air. They carried out a fair test as they investigated the relationship between the surface area of parachute canopies and how long they took to get to the ground. *It is fair to say that the wider the surface area, the longer it takes for the parachute to get to the ground.*
