This course is available to parents and carers of school age children. This workshop will cover how your child is taught to calculate with Money in the classroom. The workshop will also offer practical applications and examples of how to make the most effective use of money within a family budget.

- Example assessment / activities plus tips for home learning
- Calculating best value and effective money management with simple worked examples
