Any **reasonable adjustments** 

Any **specific access requirements** 



You can **tell** the employer that you have Developmental Language Disorder (DLD). You may want to send an **email** to say:

I have Developmental Language Disorder (DLD). This means that I have difficulties understanding spoken language and getting my message across. I may need extra support to understand your questions, and extra processing time to respond.
