The GIVE1PROJECT is a global organization that aims to engage young people as leaders in creating and building strong and healthy communities.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

The *GIVE1PROJECT Global Leadership Program* is a five-day program designed to provide opportunities for young professionals to build global networks and develop their professional and interpersonal skills. Participants will engage in discussions with American business leaders, political pundits, congressmen, senators and other young professionals in the United States to broaden their understanding of U.S. culture, politics and establish connections. Additionally, to develop a more nuanced experience, participants will visit suburban areas of Washington D.C. to witness how public policies impact the lives of American citizens.

The program also endeavors to bring together future leaders from around the world and the United States to build cultural bridges and work to solve community problems. The program is not only about developing skills and learning to build a community initiative, but also about building relationships and an international network as well as sharing culture and history. Participants are selected from a diverse pool that seeks to attract the most driven and engaged youth.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

To participate in the *GIVE1PROJECT GLOBAL LEADERSHIP PROGRAM*, applicants:

- Must demonstrate leadership potential
- Must be between 21 - 38 years old
- Applicants must obtain their own travel and medical insurance (proof of insurance is required)
- If accepted must provide a list of dietary restrictions and medical/ health related issues and sign a Medical Disclosure Form
- Must be able to travel to the United States from **Monday, September 22nd - Saturday, September 27th**
- Participants will be required to cover their ground transportation expenses
- Give1 will cover housing accommodations for a discounted rate
