The Chorus will be 16 strong in each performance and requires you to sing both in unison and in parts (SATB), so we just want to make sure that you are a confident singer. We will have an accompanist for you, so please bring 2 copies of the song you'd like to sing for us.

Please prepare:

- a short song or extract of a song from any musical (no more than 3 mins in length).
- a short extract from The Mould that Changed the World (available at the link below along with a recording to help you learn the piece).
