EBM 301: Freehand Compositions & Color Theory

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This is a studio-based course that presents the students with a variety of drawing techniques to improve their drawing skills.

The course is divided into three main sections:

- Gesture drawing- sketching the basic forms of the subject without details.
- Contour line drawing-drawing the details of all the edges of the subject.
- Rendering phase- adding shadow to the subject to give it depth and realism.

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

- Practice different exercises of eye-hand coordination and visual composition.
- Apply freehand sketching techniques, line types, hatching methods and pictorial visualization to render 2 and 3D subjects.
- Perform ability to draw from observation
- Demonstrate the ability of applying freehand design, nuances, shades. Tattoo drawings on surfaces and skin.








CIAAD edu Emphasis Master Course offering template
