#### What Are We Going to Do?



Norfolk County Council plans to make a **new agreement** with our NHS partners.



This agreement will be called a "Section 75 Partnership Agreement".

This is because the current agreement is coming to an end. The first agreement was made over 10 years ago.

# Norfolk County Council will make a new partnership agreement with these organisations:



- Norfolk Community Health and Care NHS Trust (NCH&C)
- Hertfordshire Partnership University NHS Foundation Trust (HPFT)
- NHS Norfolk and Waveney Clinical Commissioning Group (the CCG)

### Why Are We Doing It?



Section 75 Agreements are designed to **improve** services for you by allowing NHS organisations and local authorities to work together.



This partnership agreement will allow us to **keep** delivering supportive services for people with learning disabilities and/or autism.

#### Which Services are Included?



The agreements will cover these services for people aged over 18 with learning disabilities and / or autism:

Adult Autism Assessment

NCH&C

Community Learning Disability Teams

NCH&C

Community Psychiatry

HPFT

Short Breaks (respite for complex needs)



# Which Services Are We Investing In?



The new agreements will not reduce the amount of money invested in these specialist services.





In 2021/22 new funds have already been invested in:

- <u>Autism assessment</u> including pre and post diagnostic support.
- More <u>intensive support services</u>, so that there are more staff available at the weekend.
- Positive Behaviour Support across our health and care services
- More <u>specialist inpatient placements</u> in Norfolk, so people can access the treatment they need closer to home
