# What is Coproduction? (1)



Coproduction ensures that views from the people who will be affected most by decisions are included right from the start.

## What is Coproduction? (2)



This means that when a big decision is being made, such as new residential housing being built, people who may use it can share their views and make sure that it works well.

## Value every member



- Everyone is considered equal. No one person or group is more important than any other person or group.

# Accessibility (1)



- Everyone has the same opportunity to take full part in an activity in the way that suits them best.

## Accessibility (2)



- This could include physical access but also clear, accessible information free from jargon.

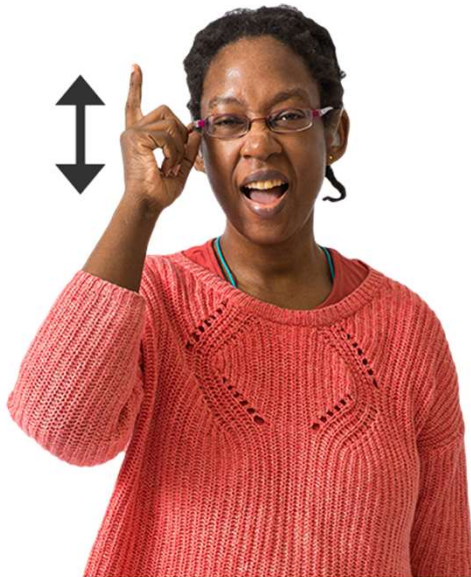
## Respect (1)



- Where there is disagreement between members, they will challenge each other's viewpoint respectfully.



## Respect (2)



**Understand**

- Members will first seek to understand through listening to what another member is expressing and then confirm that understanding.

## Respect (3)



- Members understand that we are all working together to make things better.

# Working Together (1)



- All members will come together at the earliest opportunity to find shared solutions to problems, defining realistic goals and working together from the start to the end of a project.

## Working Together (2)



- All members contribute to a project in a meaningful way.

## Confidentiality (1)



- There may sometimes be issues around confidentiality and information sharing, such as members receiving information that should not be shared outside the group.

## Confidentiality (2)



- When confidential information cannot be provided a reason will be given.
