The Norwegian Chinese Friendship Association was established in 2018 by former parliamentarians, diplomats, businessmen and academics having worked with promoting friendly relations between our two countries over many decades. Our main aim is, using our substantial networks in Norway and China, to help facilitate development of people to people exchanges between our two countries. Our main mission

is to identify opportunities for exchanges with focus on the arts, education and health arenas. These are sectors that have deep roots in our cultures and where we can learn from each other and helping to create mutual understandings between our peoples. Our partnership with CPAFFC and their over 1000 local chapters gives us an important platform for building potential exchange activities in a broad sector of society that ultimately can contribute to creating long term partnerships.



China People's Association for Friendship with Foreign Countries

*The CPAFFC is a national people's organization engaged in people-to-people diplomacy of the People's Republic of China with the purposes of enhancing people's friendship, furthering international cooperation, safeguarding world peace and promoting common development.*

*CPAFFC has been an important organization to promote China's policy of peace, observing the Five Principles of Peaceful Coexistence - ideas that were first put forward by the then Chinese Premier Zhou Enlai in 1953 and that became part of the agreement on bilateral relations between India and China, incorporated in the Charter of the United*

*Nations and of the Non-Aligned Movement of the Global South. These principles are: (i) mutual respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity, (ii) mutual non-aggression, (iii) non-interference in each other's internal affairs, (iv) equality and mutual benefit, and finally and most importantly (v) peaceful coexistence.*

*In 1971 the CPAFFC became famous for facilitating the so-called ping-pong diplomacy that laid the ground work for the opening of diplomatic relations between China and the United States with the historic visit of U.S. President Richard Nixon to China the following year.*

NORGES GRÜNDERFORENING OG SMB NORGE

## Bakgrunnsinformasjon til Prosjektet

I november 2019 signerte Norsk forening for små og mellomstore bedrifter - SMB Norge – en intensjonsavtale med «China and Foreign Countries Entrepreneurs Alliance» (CFEA). CFEA er et prosjekt initiert av «China Small and Medium Enterprises» (CASME) med hovedoppgaven å legge til rette for samarbeid mellom utenlandske og kinesiske SMBer. Med det som utgangspunkt vil Gründerforeningen i samarbeid med SMB Norge lansere prosjektet Norsk Kinesisk Entreprenør Allianse som vil kunne presentere norske teknologier og tjenester til det kinesiske markedet.



Siden Kina ble medlem av WTO i oktober 2001, med sin enorme befolkning på over 1,4 milliarder, har fremveksten av Kina som en viktig aktør på verdensscenen skapt nye muligheter, men også geopolitiske utfordringer og fremveksten av opplevde geopolitiske rivaliseringer.

Kina er nå en integrert og avgjørende bidragsyter til den globale økonomien og den viktigste handelspartner til mer enn 120 land og den nest viktigste økonomien etter USA målt med bruttonasjonal produkt (BNP) og den største økonomien målt i kjøpekraft Paritet (PPP).

Kina er nå driveren for den kraftige økonomiske veksten i sine naboland (ASEAN) og den globale økonomien. Inntil nylig har Kina vist bemerkelsesverdig motstands-kraft i møte med gjeldende handels- og økonomiske begrensninger på grunn av en veritabel eksplosiv økning i en innenlandsk tjenestebasert industri. Innføringen av politikken for såkalt "Rural Revitalization", landsbyfornyingsstrategi sammen med handels-integrasjon, har vært driveren for utryddelsen av fattigdom i Kina.
