#### **Important Notes That Must be Taken into Consideration**

- Share the below protocols with your children.
- Support the schools' decisions in front of your children, so that they feel positive about the return to school albeit under unusual circumstances.
- **KG 1** students morning arrival on the first day, have to be by their parents, as bus service will be operated for bus subscribers starting from the dismissal of the first day.
- Please note that it is completely and definitively prohibited for all students to bring mobile phones to school; this is in implementation of the Ministerial Decision issued to schools – Excluding from that, certain cases of extreme necessity with some regulations, and the mechanism for applying these exceptions will be sent later on the E-learning platform - COLNN.

### Educational Process for the Academic Year 2023-2024

Our plan for the new academic year will basically depend on a blended learning process and the "Flipped Classroom" approach, based on "Bloom's Classification Models" to boost students' thinking and perception skills. This will be depending on recorded videos prepared and presented by our distinguished teachers, which will be uploaded on our school platform — COLNN; to be discussed in class with the students to reach the required thinking and perception skills.

As for the educational process, it will include face to face education and online sessions (if needed, according to the school academic vision, or any uncounted circumstances).

- The school opens its gates for the dismissal of the non-bus subscribers as follows:
  - Kindergarten and Lower Primary at 1:35 p.m.
  - o From 4<sup>th</sup> primary till 3<sup>rd</sup> secondary at **1:40 p.m.**
- Please, be committed to the mentioned timings, as it will not be allowed to let the students be at school before 06:35 AM or after 02:15 PM. Your commitment is appreciated and respected, out of our concern about the safety of our children, as there will be no supervision before or after these timings.

#### **Important Notes:**

Since the safety and the security of our sons and daughters is the highest priority for both of us, so we kindly ask you to be keen and selective about the private representatives, drivers, and matrons that you pick for the students to drop them off at school or to pick them up, as they must have honesty, be well mannered with good appearance. #### **Important Notes:**

- Two ID Cards will be issued to kindergarteners. One of them must be worn daily by the student at school, especially in the first day and within the first month of school, as well as during the school trips. As for the other ID Card, it is for the non-bus subscribers, and it must be shown daily by the adult who picks up the child from school throughout the school year, knowing that children are not allowed to be handed over to their siblings at school except to those who are in the preparatory stage and up, and showing the ID Card is also a MUST. As for the first and second primary, they will receive only an ID Card to be used for picking them up under the same conditions.
- It is not permitted for the student to leave during the school day, except in emergency cases and not on a frequent basis, in order to ensure the regularity of the educational process and in implementation with the decisions of the Ministry of Education. Leaving in this case, should be maximum at 01:15 PM and that must be in the presence of the parent/guardian along with having previous permission from the stage headmaster/mistress.





#### **Official Communication Channels**

We at NLS believe that **COMMUNICATION** is the key to success. So, if you have any inquiries or complaints, we are here and glad to receive it through our official communication channels – (**note that no complaints are to be considered through any other means**).

- You can send any messages or inquiries through the message board on the schools' platform - COLNN, as it is the simplest and fastest official way to contact teachers and the school's administration, and replies will be within 24 Hours, except for Thursdays will be within 48 Hours.
