Four new Ad Hoc circles have joined the Nordic Summer University (NSU) for one-year study programs (2 symposia) for 2022.

The board of the Nordic Summer University (NSU) is happy to announce that the call for proposals for three 'ad hoc' study programs has been successful. Although it was planned to accept only three new study programs, the board finally decided to accept four instead of three proposals.

The accepted proposals include:

- Circle 2: Human-technology futures: making art, doing theory, shaking things up (Ad hoc circle 2022) led by Eric Deibel, Palle Dahlstedt, and Maru Mushtrieva
- Circle 9: Decolonization and Social Work (Ad hoc circle 2022) led by Kris Clarke and collaborators.
- Circle 10: Art and creative practices as a tool to interpret, redefine and appropriate heritage of the Nordic-Baltic regions (Ad hoc circle 2022) led by Svetlana Kondratyeva and Stsiapan Stureika.
- Circle 11: Environmental Aesthetics and Space based ethics of care (Ad hoc circle 2022) led by Neli Dobreva and Tereza Stehlikova.
