

Getting to the city centre from the airport

By train

Train connects airport and central railway station (Geležinkelio st. 16, Vilnius). When you get out from the airport arrivals, you will see signs to the train stop (it's about 5 minutes' walk on nicely paved path).

Duration: 8 minutes from airport to the central railway station

Frequency: it does not go very often, but if your arrival time coincides with the train timetable, it would be fastest way to reach the center.

Itinerary: you can check train schedule here (Vilnius Airport > Vilnius and back):

Where to buy ticket: you can purchase the ticket directly from the website (see link above) or at a vending machine by the train stop.

Ticket price: 0.8 EUR.

By express city bus (3G)

Bus 3G connects airport with the centre. It stops directly in front of the exit from the arrivals.

Duration: about 10-15 minutes to the stop *Mikalojaus Konstantino Čiurlionio st.* (which is 10 min walk from the very heart of the city).

Frequency: it runs every 10 minutes (or less).

Where to buy ticket: you would have to buy ticket before boarding the bus. Easiest way to do it, is to use an application (*m.ticket* or *trafi*) that you can download beforehand.

Alternative option could be to try to buy a transport card (it can be topped up with tickets) in person from a selling point (Vilnius transport website Judu mentions Narvesen, Lietuvos Spauda, and Spauda selling points). There is at least one *Narvesen* at the airport (in departures hall for sure, which you can access by going one floor up with elevator at arrivals and crossing a tiny street separating arrivals from departures building in less than a 1 minute). Note that paper tickets cannot be purchased from the driver on the bus and self-service machines (as far as I know) allow to top-up transport cards that are bought in advance (basically used by residents of the city).

Price: 30 minutes ticket costs 0.65 EUR.

Same tickets apply for buses and trolley busses in the city. You can check day ticket options etc. (if relevant) here: <https://judu.lt/en/for-public-transport-passengers/ticket-types-and-prices/>

Note that all locations (event venues) are all in about 15 min. walking radius from each other, so you might end up not using the transport ticket much (or at all) to move around in the city centre.

By taxi

Getting from airport to the city centre by taxi is also affordable option.

Easiest way would be getting a taxi using *Bolt application*. Bolt drivers have a designated area at the airport (clearly visible once you exit arrivals building). In the off-peak time, it might cost about up to 6 EUR from airport city centre/old town; early in the morning or during busier periods during the day it could go to 10-12 EUR or so.
