

## Getting to the event venues

31 March – Mikalojaus Konstantino Čiurlionio gatvė 29, room 101

The first day of the symposium will be held on Vilnius university campus on M.K.Čiurlionio street.



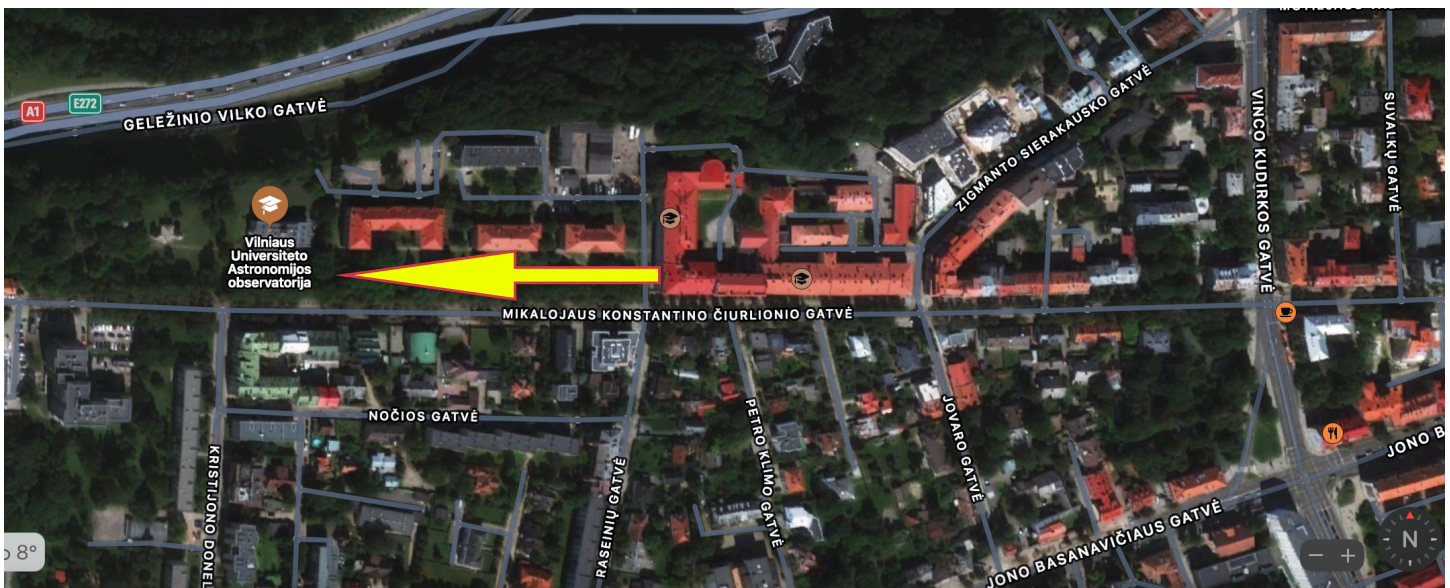
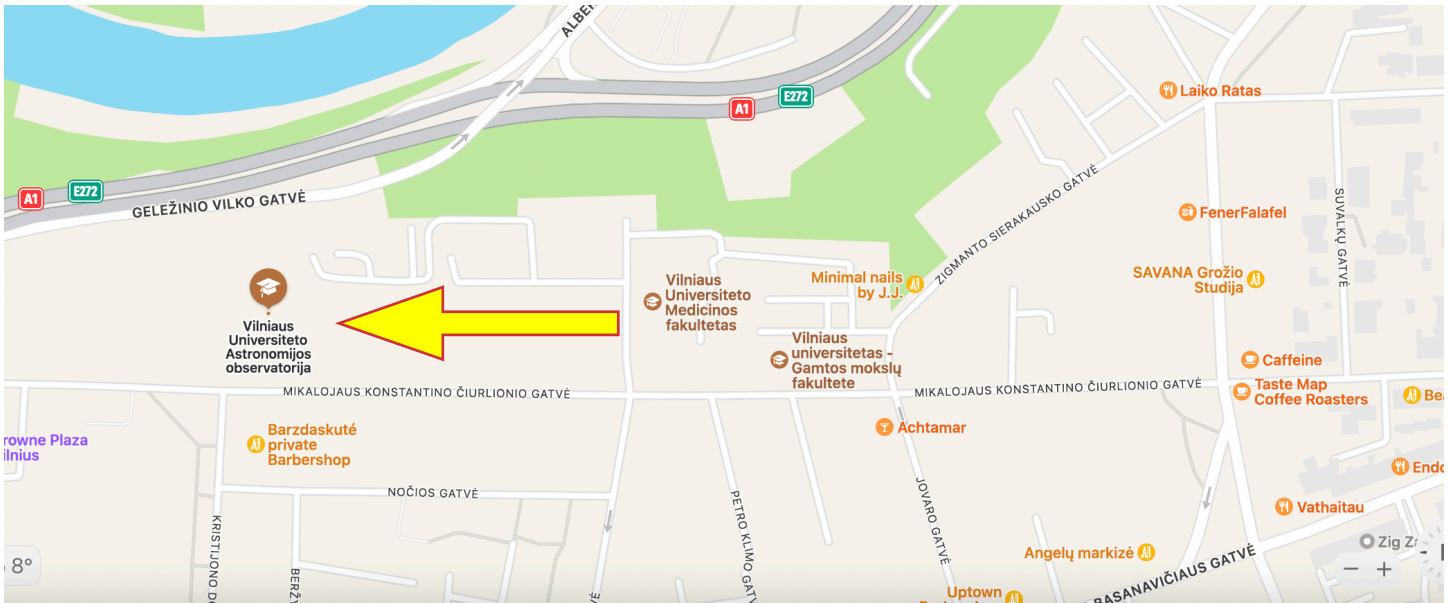

The **entry** to the campus is where the arrow starts.

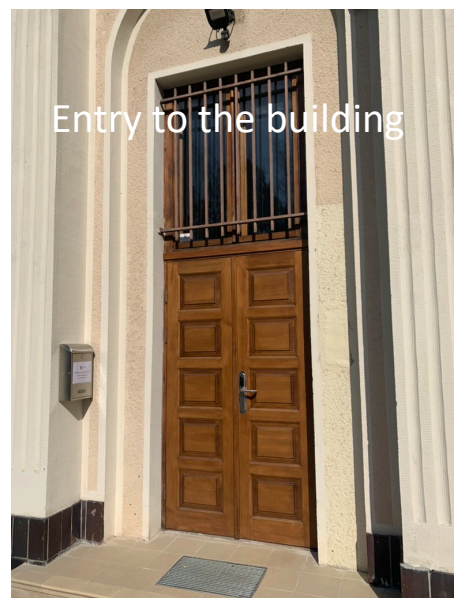




You have to walk M.K. Čiurlionio st. until you reach M.K. Čiurlionio st. 21, which is an entry to the university complex.



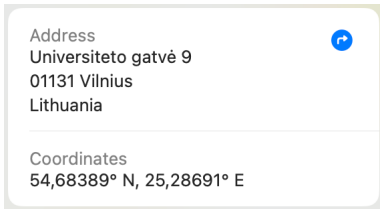
When you enter through the gate, turn left by that little green “house” (security post) and continue all the way straight until you reach the very last building. It will be M.K. Čiurlionio st. 29 – venue for the first day. In the picture in the middle you can see the side of the building, continue straight and you’ll find the entry. **IF LOST, CALL +370 682 52 478 (Irma)**





## 1 April – Universiteto gatvė 9, room 201

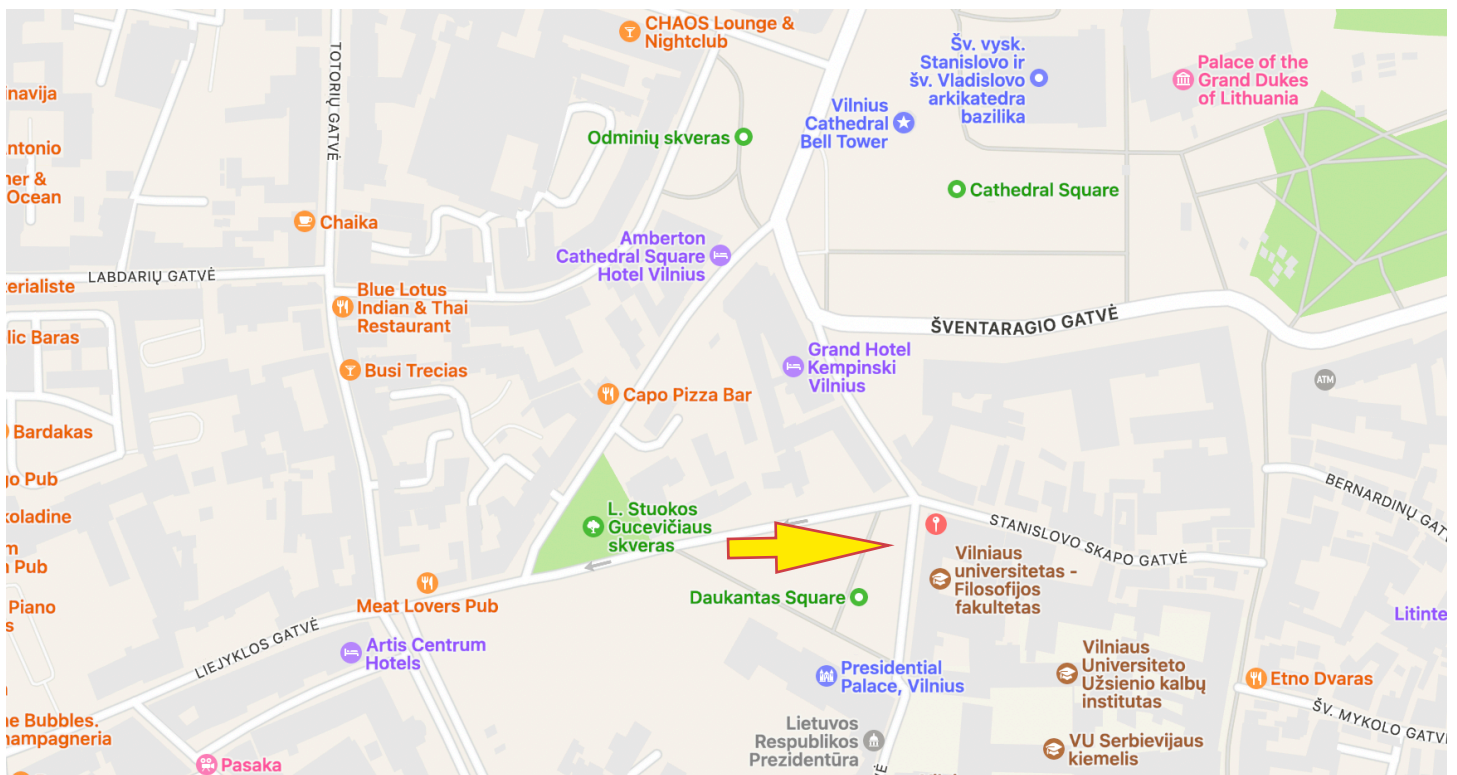
The second day of the symposium will be held on Vilnius university campus in the old town - Faculty of Philosophy.



Note: wearing masks is obligatory in Lithuania inside the buildings.

On the map it is called Vilniaus universitetas - Filosofijos fakultetas. It is situated next to the President Palace.

The main entry to the building is where the yellow arrow points on the map.



After you enter the yard, you continue straight and you'll find main entry. Stairs are on the right when you enter. Room 201 is on the second floor (note that ground floor is counted as first floor in Lithuania). **IF LOST, CALL +370 682 52 478 (Irma)**
