Five main research categories:

- 1. Trees and shrubs mainly spring and summer, some all year round
- 2. Butterflies in summer, ie once a week April – September, using the same route round the garden
- 3. **Birds** all year round
- 4. Animals, insects, invertebrates
- 5. Flowers and grasses spring and summer

A possible sixth category, **Bats**, could be scheduled in September **Using phone apps** is probably the best way of identifying all of the above, although we might pay for an entomologist to help with category 4.
