In order of consideration

1. Under Criteria #2 Oblate Community

a(1)-Oblates in formation should participate in any decision making meetings regarding the future.

b)---That future congresses and meetings be held in Japanese.

2.--Under Criteria # 2 Apostolic Ministries

f)---That the Province clarify its stand on the Apostolic Ministries in which Oblates are involved.

g)---That Apostolic Ministries not merely be allowed, but that those involved in Apostolic Ministries be missioned.

3.--Under Criteria # 5 Oblate Community

Steps For Implementation of Suggestions of the Congress

In order to implement the suggestions we will establish a timetable to treat each Apostolic Ministry with the man involved. We will try not to overburden you but will ask for your cooperation. For most of the Apostolic Ministries the process will be simple.

1. Apostolic Ministries in General

- a) A simple questionnaire (not repeating but taking advantage of the work done by each one in preparation of the Congress).
- b) A meeting between the Provincial and each Oblate to dialogue about his Apostolic Ministry.
- c) The Provincial Council will then take a proposed position about the Ministry--which, if necessary, will be discussed by the whole community for approval as the official Province position.

2. Apostolic Ministry -- Parishes

The suggestions about parishes will take a longer but processes will be set up as soon as possible to implement the suggestions about this Apostolic Ministry.

3. Apostolic Ministry -- Kindergartens

The process for implementing the suggestions will be formulated in a future meeting with those involved in in this Apostolic Ministry.

CRITERIA

1. In order to better determine what the Spirit is calling us to here and no, we will submit our works to prayerful discernment on the local, district and provincial level.
- 2. We will seek out and gear our works to the most abandoned.
- 3. We will embrace a life style which reflects an open and respectful attitude toward the Japanese and their culture.
- 4. We will stand up against injustice and will work to foster Kingdom values.
- 5. We will foster all lay ministries and integrate them into our Mission.
- 6. We will maintain a life style that reflects a spirit of simplicity, challenging the false absolutes of money, power, and exploitation.
7. We will strive to form communities that are characterized by communal prayer, a sincere and mutual concern, and unity of purpose.
8. We will have a continuous ongoing formation program in the Province.
