During the April 2015 Spring meeting at Munakata, Fukuoka the group met after a year of hiatus. The members then recalled the past OGF gatherings, especially the gatherings that took place for the past three years.

2015— The group planned to gather in Korea since the all the members of the delegation will gather in Korea for the 25th founding anniversary of the mission in Korea. However, the plan was not materialized.
