April 28 has been declared World Art Deco Day by the International Coalition of Art Deco Societies (ICADS). Indeed, it was on April 28, 1925 that the International Exhibition of Modern Decorative and Industrial Arts opened in Paris. The general public then discovered a style, which was called modern and which would later be called "Art Deco".

For this year 2021, due to the health situation, ICADS member associations who wished, were simply asked to offer online conferences.

The conference program runs throughout April and is available on the ICADS website.

The Paris Art Deco Society Association (APADS) had to respond to this first edition of World Art Deco Day, especially as it plans to host the World Art Deco Congress in 2025, precisely on the occasion of the centenary of the Paris Exposition.

Pascal Yves Laurent, President of APADS, will describe the spirit of what has animated the World Art Deco Congresses since their creation in 1991.

Then he will imagine what Paris could be like in 2025. He will outline a project that occupies visitors for six days: conferences, urban walks, cultural visits, restaurants, parties. This will of course be a project as it is still too early to be able to come up with a finalized program.

The pre-congress and post-congress will also be unveiled. Besides its champagne, Reims presents an architecture which announces the exhibition of 1925. Saint-Quentin has remarkable interior spaces perfectly restored. The Palace of Justice and the City Hall of Béthune are worth a detour. In the Metropolis of Lille, the Villa Cavrois and the Piscine Museum are unmissable, Brussels will mark the final and international point of the course.
