a) Visit the Parish Giving Scheme website:

<u>https://www.parishgiving.org.uk</u> quoting parish name, Boyatt Wood, and parish code, 416010041, to set up your one-off or regular gift by direct debit. If you wish to make your gift tax-effective, the site will allow you to complete a gift aid declaration online too.

b) **Set up a standing order with your online banking** in favour of "PCC of St Peter's Church Boyatt Wood", sort code 60-18-46, account number 72281308, quoting your name as the reference. If you wish to make your gift tax-effective, please download a <u>gift aid declaration here</u>, then complete it and return it to the PCC Treasurer c/o the Parish Office.

c) **Use the digital bank card reader at the entrance to the worship area** to make a one-off gift of an amount of your choice. This will also enable you to make an online gift aid declaration should you wish to make your gift tax-effective.

d) Make a cash donation in the offertory plate available at all worship services.
