## To Thermopylae -Plataea -Marathon/Athens

This trip takes you to the absolutely core of our culture, in places and theory: Thermopylae, Plataea/Boiotia, Marathon Beach and Athens. Here were the first blows in defense of democracy. The theme of the trip is how the Greek culture occurs, and the Athenians thought about development, leadership, responsibility, courage and fellowship. At Thermopylae, King Leonidas and the "300" fought together with 700 Thespians.



The battle at Marathon is the origin of the marathon-run around the world: Plataea was the scene of the last major and decisive battle in these battles of the Persian war, 11 years after the Battle of Marathon. The Classical Greeks developed our cultural cradle, from the seeds of their culture. This was not by luck, but by awareness about knowledge, communication and leadership. The first day we walk 20 kilometers down the mountain to the battlefield at Thermopylae, led by the Athenian George, the warrior in picture. You will meet warriors, actors and join battle-camps, from doitinathens(facebook).



This tomb at Marathon (Marathon Museum) contains 8 remains of Plataeas fallen. They are visible under the arch of the Tomb. Here was a boy of about 12 years who was killed during the battle, laid under the potsherds. He was their bid; their "Pheidippides", to tell home, about victory or annihilation.
