

Trip to Plataea, Marathon/Athens, 2019

Join the exciting trip to Plataea, Marathon Beach and Athens, along with me, Anders P. Petersen (Norway). Here was the first battle in defense of democracy. Marathon-the race, coming off the legend of Pheidippides running from Marathon to Athens to tell about the Plataea on the way to the battle of Marathon, where they fought alongside the Athenians. Plataea was also the site of the last major and decisive battle against the Persians, 11 years after the battle at Marathon.

This tomb at Marathon (Marathon Museum) contains 8 remains of Plataeans killed in the battle. They are visible under the Arch of the Tomb. One, a boy at the age of about 12, laid under the potsherds. He was the messenger; their "Pheidippides", to tell home, about victory or annihilation.

The theme of the trip is how the Greek culture occurs, and the Athenians thought about invention and development, leadership and responsibility, communication, and in particular the rationale for parrhesia; fearless speech. This has great relevance for our time, for the development of society, and democracy.
