For the public benefit, promote the arts of drama, music and dance in Hillingdon and the surrounding areas through in particular but not exclusively the arts of musical theatre;		
a. by enabling the instruction of dance, music and drama which supports people of all levels of experience and ability;	b. by enabling the local community to have affordable access to the dramatic arts; and	c. to further develop local community appreciation of said art through staging of performances and other activities.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Annual AGM, maximum interval of 15 months. • 14 days' notice of AGM • EGMs may be called 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vote at AGM by anonymous poll if requested by 10% of Members • 33% attendance for AGM to be quorate 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 20% of Members can propose resolutions. • 20% of Members can require an AGM, to be held within 28 days 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Simple majority vote at AGM for ordinary decisions • 75% vote required to change constitution or wind up Pastiche 	
Informal and associate membership		
Trustees may create associate membership such as Friends of Pastiche.	Associates are non-voting	
Honorary roles		
Trustees may at their discretion create and appoint persons to Honorary roles, such as patron and President, for a term of the Trustees choice.
