## What's going on at EU level?

- The European Commission presented in November 2022 a proposal for a Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation, including reuse targets for 2030 and 2040.
- In November 2023, the European Parliament adopted its proposed amendments to the text and in December 2023 the Council of the EU did the same.
- Now, and before early March at the latest, the three EU institutions are discussing to real a final agreement.
- This is, in a nutshell, what is on the table:

	No real exemption mechanism	Several exemption mechanisms: LCA, collection and recycling rates	One exemption for exceptional circumstances & Pooling system allowed
