Kick-off PlastTrack

In April, our project team organized the Kick-off meeting in Sønderborg and welcomed not only all PlastTrack partners but also some network partners. The team reviewed all the tasks and plans, and defined the necessary working groups. The partners are highly motivated to provide tools that track the path of plastic waste and contribute to preventing further uncontrolled micro- and nanoplastic releases. One of the key objectives of the project is to develop label-free chemical analysis, which will encourage regional pollution mapping. However, the project is not limited to this. The partners also aim to transfer their results to industrial settings and create new tools that could be implemented in existing web-based safety guidance instructions. The project team is committed to making a positive impact on the environment and looks forward to the interaction with all stakeholders.
