We need to own ourselves again

What do we want?

We want a medical record that is accessible everywhere in the world. Wherever you are you should have easy access to it.

It should also be locked and not available to anyone when you are not in a hospital or in need of care.

Why don't we have this already?

Today we have shared custody of the medical records. You own the data in your record but the hospital or care taker owns the paper it is written on. When it comes to electronic medical records the situation is even worse. You still own the information but the computer software and computer hardware is owned by the hospital.

How can we solve this?

The solution is to create a system, for both software and hardware, that is totally owned by the user. That is, the patient. That is, you.

This can be achieved by combining three key concepts: open source, peer to peer and wiki.

The technologies that are perfect to use for this solution is called IPFS and DokuWiki. This is what the development is based upon.



How will it be funded?

The heart of the system needs to be free and open source in order to be trusted and live forever. So pttp.org must be a non-profit organisation.

However, when the system is in place there will be a lot of opportunities for businesses to create an ecosystem of additional services around the solution.
