A SUCCESSFUL COMBINATION OF RESTORATION WORKS, ALTERATION AND NEW CONSTRUCTION

• To the former City Hall at Leest large-scale restoration works were necessary and at the adjacent school alteration works were planned. Again as most interesting party, after a public price request launched by the Technical Department of the City of Mechlin, **RAMAST LTD CONSTRUCTION CY** obtained from the city council the order for the implementation of the project.

The mission was very varied and dealt with all specialities regarding restoration works, together with all disciplines for alteration and new construction. So a.o a new refectory was added on, the existing sanitary of the school was extended, the attick was finished for public use and the pinacles of the dormers were covered with gold leaf.

The icing on the cake was the full optimal reinstatement of the front and the rear facade of the former city Hall, by inspecting and complete restoring of the original brickwork dressing, all natural stone outside wall parties and the wrought ironwork.

Finally for protection of the performed work the facades were finished with a biodegradable half- permanent anti-graffiti coating against “paint vandalism”



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
